General Comments:

- Should work together with afternoon class on schedules so that presentations, tests, etc do not coincide. Classroom on 4th floor much better than upstairs. Yu was a very good instructor! I learned a great deal about clinical trial methodology.
- Extremely well organized course. Excellent notes. The course might benefit from one lecture on practical aspects of clinical trials - ways to increase participation, problems of follow up, etc -- perhaps given by an experienced clinical trialist.
- Very well organized. Very helpful. I think the statistics as it is integrated is difficult to incorporate into the course. Perhaps it could be spread out. Dr. Shyr was enthusiastic and helpful. This was a very good course. The text was as good as it could be.
- I think since I haven't taken Biostat-1 and my experience in clinical trials is very limited as I have joined clinical research trials from Aug 1998. To my comments on evaluation are based on my limited experience. The text I think should be more elaborative to explain. But the teaching part is excellent.
- Very good course overall. I learned a great deal. I think the final protocol project should be discussed earlier in the course, so it can be developed over the 3 weeks rather than during just the last week. Very limited time for reading the text.
- Dr. Shyr puts in a tremendous amount of effort in preparing and teaching this course, which is highly appreciated. A better text would help. Although there is not much time to read it anyway.
- Dr. Shyr did an excellent job organizing the course and put an enormous effort into it. I thought it was taught from the perspective of a Biostatistician rather than a clinical trialist.

I would decrease the intensity of the statistics and increase the number of clinical trials reviewed.

General Comments:

- Dr. Shyr was a great teacher—thorough, smart, and effective—I truly learned a lot from his class.
- The only “con” so to speak was the wide variation in epidemiologic and Biostatistics backgrounds of the class participants—namely, some non-MPH and non-MSCI students with no background on stats or epi tended to drag the discussion down at times.
- Overall, I think it is a wonderful course. It covers a lot of topics within 3 weeks. I like it very much.
- The course books are excellent—very helpful. I also like having the opportunity to do in-class exercises. The guest speakers were very good, also.
- Dr. Shyr was EXCELLENT! He is a great communicator and a very effective teacher. The course was excellent. The acquisition of knowledge concerning the design and conduct of clinical trials exceeded my expectations. The only concern I have is regarding the course work and duration of the course. Because the course is only conducted over essentially 3 weeks, the homework, midterm and final exam required lots of effort and time to complete and design. I think most of the students still have significant clinical or research duties outside of the class, so it was difficult to accomplish all of the assigned work in the allotted time. Possible lengthening the course to 4-6 weeks would help alleviate some of these burdens. Just a suggestion.

- Yu Shyr is an excellent instructor and should be recognized for his efforts. The lecture on clinical equivalence trial should be revised- the lecture notes were intended for a audience of statisticians. Also, the last lecture (by Paul Larsen) was quite weak. All in all though, an excellent course.
- Excellent course. Enjoyable even when it is not a simple topic. The quality of the instructor is superior. Thanks!

General Comments:

- Excellent course! Instructor was very patient, encouraging to students.

I feel like we had very little guidance for the final (unlike the midterm) and so many of us feel rather lost. Overall, though, it was a great class!!

- Again, a lot of information in a very short time period. It would be better to have four weeks for this course. Very helpful to have the notes bound and organized I did not find the book very helpful.

- We definitely need the hard copy of course pack. We learned a lot. I appreciate it. With regard to "database" it was a little redundant for MSCI student. Because we had 3-hour lecture from Dr. Paul Harris.
- Very nice course. At times, it is very basic and I would have liked to have seen more detail and more complex topics covered.
